You will have to figure out for your given ASN if OrgID consolidation is a need. Once you have gained access to the portal, your best bet is to navigate to <https://account.arin.net/public/secure/org> and see how many OrgIDs are listed. Note, it is possible that there are OrgIDs listed for your organization that you do NOT access to. The best way to figure that out might be to use "whois" to look up the orgIDs listed for IP space belonging to your campus. If you need help determining the latter, reach out to us at WAN-ROUTING@LISTS.WISC.EDU <[wan-routing@lists.wisc.edu](mailto:wan-routing@lists.wisc.edu)>. Note, that if you don't have access to an OrgID, they will try to make contact with the current record holder they have on file. If that's on an option, you will be trailblazing; that is not a bridge we had to cross at UW Madison.

Here is my suggested opening for your ticket. This is not the exact text of my original inquiry; it has been modified based on what I now know.

Hello-
